

“SOCIETY ACT”

CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS
(REVISED 1996)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Society shall be:
89 (Pacific) R.C.A.C.S. Support Association

ARTICLE II PURPOSES

Section 1. The purposes of this Society are:

- (a) To sponsor and support 89 (Pacific) Squadron in all its endeavours.
- (b) To stimulate participation in all 89 (Pacific) Squadron Activities, by all Cadets.
- (c) To campaign for Government support and recognition of the Cadet Movement in Canada.
- (d) To raise, from time to time, those monies necessary to maintain and initiate 89 (Pacific) Squadron programs and activities.

ARTICLE III POLICIES

Section 1. The Policies of this Society are:

- (a) To foster participation in 89 (Pacific) Squadron and this Society Without Bias, whether it be Political, Social, Economic, Racial, Gender or Religious. This clause is unalterable.
- (b) To promote and advance the purposes of the air Cadet League of Canada, British Columbia Committee, within the rules and regulations established by the Air Cadet League of Canada, British Columbia Committee. This clause is unalterable.
- (c) To operate this Society within the are of eligibility for Cadet membership in 89 (Pacific) Squadron, except that the Society may, where it deems it to be in the interest of the Cadets, operate outside the said are for the purposes of fundraising or other projects. This clause is unalterable.

- (d) To have the Directors serve without remuneration and the Directors shall not receive, directly or indirectly, any profits from their position as Directors, but may be paid expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties. This clause is unalterable.
- (e) To operate a charitable institution (without profit to its members) for the purpose of assisting 89 (Pacific) Squadron. This clause is unalterable.
- (f) The Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its Members, no part of any income of the Society shall go to the personal benefit of the Members thereof, and any profits and other accretions to the Society shall be used for promoting its purposes. This clause is unalterable.
- (g) Upon the winding up or dissolution of this Society, any funds or assets of the Society remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liability shall be given or transferred to an organization or organizations that on a non-profit basis assist, promote, or develop programs and facilities for the benefit of the youth of our society under the age of 19 (nineteen) years within the Greater Victoria District, British Columbia, as may be decided by the Members of the Society at the time of winding up or dissolution. This clause is unalterable.
